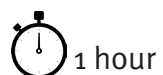

Discovering the collections with a private guide: the multimedia players

Hire a multimedia player at the reception desk. The device contains several itineraries for most of our galleries, illustrated by pictures. The interactive trail about the 19th century is full of archive documents and animated films. A specific trail is available for children 7 and older.
